The King is Coming

⁷ They brought the donkey and the colt and put on them their cloaks, and he sat on them. ⁸ Most of the crowd spread their cloaks on the road, and others cut branches from the trees and spread them on the road. ⁹ And the crowds that went before him and that followed him were shouting, "Hosanna to the Son of David! A. The King Betrayed by His Disciple

14 Then one of the Twelve—the one called Judas Iscariot—went to the chief priests **15** and asked, “What are you willing to give me if I deliver him over to you?” So they counted out for him thirty pieces of silver. **16** From then on Judas watched for an opportunity to hand him over.

B. The King Denied by His Friend

⁶⁹ Now Peter was sitting out in the courtyard, and a servant girl came to him. “You also were with Jesus of Galilee,” she said. ⁷⁰ But he denied it before them all. “I don’t know what you’re talking about,” he said. ⁷¹ Then he went out to the gateway, where another servant girl saw him and said to the people there, “This fellow was with Jesus of Nazareth.” ⁷² He denied it again, with an oath: “I don’t know the man!”

B. The King Denied by His Friend

73 After a little while, those standing there went up to Peter and said, "Surely you are one of them; your accent gives you away." **74** Then he began to call down curses, and he swore to them, "I don't know the man!" Immediately a rooster crowed. **75** Then Peter remembered the word Jesus had spoken: "Before the rooster crows, you will disown me three times." And he went outside and wept bitterly.



C. The King Rejected by His People

- ¹⁵ Now it was the governor's custom at the festival to release a prisoner chosen by the crowd. ¹⁶ At that time they had a well-known prisoner whose name was Jesus Barabbas.
- ¹⁷ So when the crowd had gathered, Pilate asked them, "Which one do you want me to release to you: Jesus Barabbas, or Jesus who is called the Messiah?" ¹⁸ For he knew it was out of self-interest that they had handed Jesus over to him.

D. The King Stripped, Beaten, and Mocked

27 Then the governor's soldiers took Jesus into the Praetorium and gathered the whole company of soldiers around him.

28 They stripped him and put a scarlet robe on him, **29** and then twisted together a crown of thorns and set it on his head. They put a staff in his right hand. Then they knelt in front of him and mocked him. "Hail, king of the Jews!" they said.

D. The King Stripped, Beaten, and Mocked

30 They spit on him, and took the staff and struck him on the head again and again. **31** After they had mocked him, they took off the robe and put his own clothes on him. Then they led him away to crucify him.

E. The King Crucified

35 When they had crucified him, they divided up his clothes by casting lots. **36** And sitting down, they kept watch over him there. **37** Above his head they placed the written charge against him:
THIS IS JESUS, THE KING OF THE JEWS.




